In "Invasion Class"



SELMAN FIELD, Monroe, La.—Flight Officer Walter E. Reynolds, son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank B. Reynolds, 848 Mechanic Street, was a member of Selman Field's "invasion class" of aerial navigation cadets who received their wings and commissions in ceremonies recently in the post theater—the first class to graduate after the landing of the Allied invasion army on the continent of Europe. Trained under the direction of the AAF Training Command and under the direct supervision of the AAF Central Flying Training Command, the navigators, members of Class 44-8, represented 33 states of the union, and will shortly be sent to operational and replacement training units, throughout the country, where they will train with their future crew-mates for the knock-out blow against the Axis.
