Renew Acquaintances
Meeting In Britain**

Renewal of memories and an exchange of the common experiences of war furnished two Bethlehem boys, who met unexpectedly in England last week, plenty to talk about in the afternoon they spent together.

The boys are Sergeant Robert A. "Babe" MacWilliam, Jr., of the U. S. Army Air Forces, former Liberty High School football star; who has been overseas since December, 1943, and Corporal Harry L. Dillinger, Jr., son of Undertaker and Mrs. Harry L. Dillinger, who received the letter describing the happy meeting.

Sergeant MacWilliam was inducted in December 1942, and received his training in New Cumberland, Pa.; Pocatello, Idaho; Kearns, Utah and March Field, Cal.

Corporal Dillinger entered the service in November 1942, training with the medical corps at Camp Phillips, Salina, Kan. He shipped overseas in the fall of 1943.
