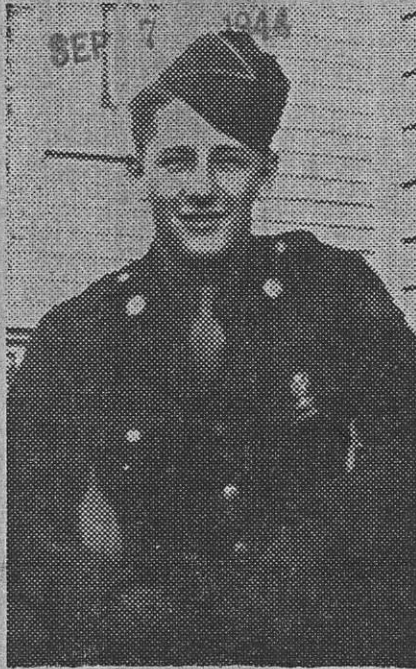

Nazareth Soldier Seriously Wounded In French Action

Mr. and Mrs. Nevin E. Werkheiser, Sr., of 114 Walnut Street, Nazareth, have received a telegram from the War Department informing them that their son, Pfc. Nevin E. Werkheiser, Jr., was seriously wounded in action in France on August 18. He is the husband of Mrs. Doris Werkheiser of Easton R. D. 2 and the father of a four-month-old son whom he has never seen.

Pfc. Werkheiser entered the Army on April 5, 1943, with a Tank Battalion, and received his training at Camp Campbell, Ky., and Camp Phillips, Kans., before going overseas to England in April and then to France.
