Arrives in China

Pfc. Edward C. Danish, U. S. Marine Corps, has arrived in China from Guam, according to word received by his father, Andrew Danish, Sr., Bethlehem R. D. 1, Brown's Crossing. He is stationed near Tsing Tao Harbor.

Pfc. Danish entered service March 23, 1944, and went overseas in August, 1944, after receiving training at Camp Lejeune, Parris Island, N. C. He served in the invasion of Okinawa and was formerly stationed on Guadalcanal.

Two brothers are also in the service, Sgt. Andrew Jr., in the Army four years, stationed in Texas, and Pfc. John S., who has served in England for the duration as a teletype operator for the 8th Air Force and is expected home shortly.
