Cited For Aiding Wounded Soldier Under Enemy Fire

Benjamin A. Iasiello, sergeant in the U. S. Infantry, fighting in Italy, has been awarded the Bronze Star Medal according to a First Armored

has been awarded the Bronze Star Medal according to a First Armored Division release. The citation accompanying the award stated that Sgt. Iasiello was sent forward with a squad of men to feel out enemy positions but due squad was ordered to withdraw. While withdrawing he discovered a member of his squad had been wounded and realizing it was im-possible to evacuate the wounded man at the time, he administered first aid. While another man went to the rear to secure a litter, Sgt. asiello, although under intense fire, stayed with the wounded man, con-tinuing to dress his wounds and pro-tect him until a litter team was brought forward.
