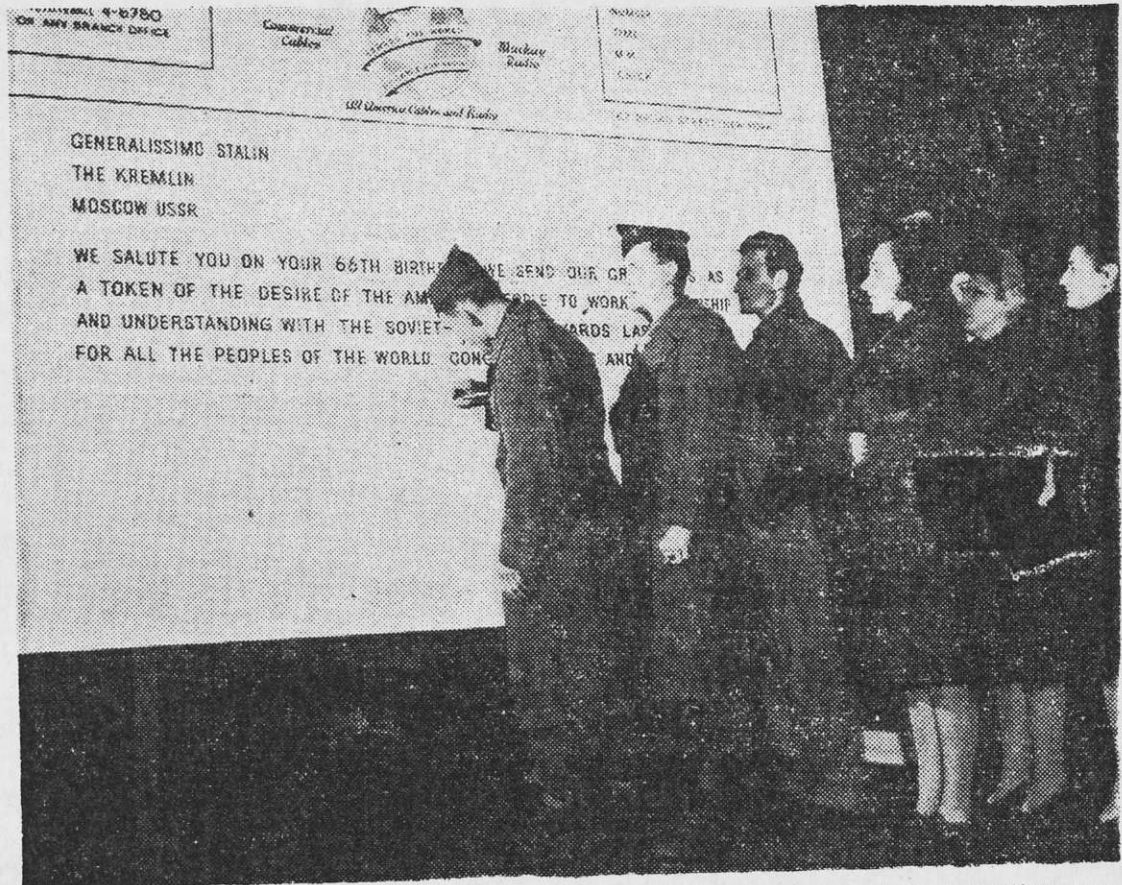


Bona, Anthony

NEW YORK—Pfc. Anthony Bona, Bethlehem, Pa., now stationed at Camp-Shanks, signs the giant 8' by 10' telegram to be sent as a birthday greeting to Premier Stalin on his 66th birthday, December 21. Telegram was set up in the lobby of the

Madison Square Garden, where a meeting, sponsored by the New York Committee for Russian Relief, was held tonight. Approximately 20,000 New Yorkers attended the meeting and contributed more than \$150,000 to the relief agency.
