**Pvt. Korpico Aids
In Harbor Project**

Pvt. Frank J. Korpico, 925 East Fifth Street, was with the United States Army Engineers in England who aided in the building of the large concrete breakwaters which were floated across the Channel shortly after D-Day to wall in the harbors improvised at the Normandy beachheads, it was revealed at headquarters, Communications Zone.

For months before D-Day, Korpico with other Engineer soldiers, worked in secret on a round-the-clock schedule, pouring concrete into vast steel ribs to form the floating breakwaters. Finally the barges were pulled from the Thames Estuary into the Channel. The constructing units are now in action in Europe.
