Bangor Soldier Made Sergeant

HEADQUARTERS 13TH AAF, Philippines—Stewart D. Buzzard, grandson of Mrs. Elizabeth C. Buzzard, 624 South High Street, Bangor, has been promoted from corporal to sergeant.

He is serving as an operations clerk in the Black Spiders Night Fighter Squadron of Brig. Gen. Earl W. Barnes' 13th AAF Fighter Command.

Stewart was graduated from Bangor High School in 1938 and prior to entering the military service was employed by the Blue Ridge Textile Company. SEP 13 1945

Sergeant Buzzard was inducted into the AAF at Ft. Meade, Md., in August 1942 and after eight months service in the United States was sent overseas to Hawaii. After five months in Hawaii he went to the Solomons where in August, 1943, he joined the 13th AAF—the Jungle Air Force which battled the Japs from Guadalcanal to Kyushu.

Sergeant Buzzard is authorized to wear the Asiatic-Pacific Campaign medal with four battle stars, the Good Conduct medal and the Philippines Liberation Ribbon with one battle star.
