Ralph W. Strunk, 22, son of Mr. and Mrs. F. L. Strunk, of 144 Main Street, Richlandtown, was a member of a class of aviation cadets to graduate from the Columbus Army Air Field near Columbus, Mississippi, Mar. 12, 1944. He received the silver wings of a Flying Officer and commission as a second lieutenant in the Army Air Forces. Lt. Strunk entered pilot training in July, 1943, and attended flying schools at Arcadia, Fla. and Courtland, Ala., before his graduation at the advanced flying school near Columbus, Mississippi.
