SOUTH PACIFIC—Everett L. McCarthy, Bethlehem, now assigned to Company F, 103rd Infantry of the crack New England 43rd Division, and now at an advanced base in the Southwest Pacific area, has recently been promoted to corporal from private first class, as an assistant squad leader in his rifle platoon.

McCarthy graduated from Bethlehem High School and afterwards was employed as a sheet metal worker at E. J. Mickley, Inc., prior to his induction into the Army May

8, 1942. He has now been overseas 14 months and has seen action during the New Georgia campaign and capture of Vangunu Island, Vella Lavella and the Munda air base.
