

# New Rules Govern Service Call News

## Draft Boards to Release Information Previously Given Out at Allentown

As selective service boards throughout the county are meeting their draft quotas for March, new orders from the Third Service Command regulate the release of the names of the men inducted. No longer will the names of men be available as they pass at the Allentown Induction center, it was learned this morning from Captain W. B. Carroll, the commanding officer.

Captain Carroll explained that the service command, under the new pool system, holds that the matter of giving out press releases will best be served if these names come from the draft boards which sent the men for examination.

This system is the result of the fact that a draft board may send a hundred men for examination and that even though they pass they may not be called for service for some time. Thus when the draft boards are notified to send a given number of men they already have selectees on the lists who have passed all requirements.

The Northampton County Selective Service Board No. 3, at Nazareth, will send two groups to the service. Tomorrow one group leaves for the Army and on Monday another will be sent to Naval training centers.
