

**S/Sgt. Harold Keeler
Earns Bronze Star
By Brave Actions**

S/Sgt. Harold S. Keeler, 1812 West Broad Street, has been awarded the Bronze Star Medal for meritorious service with the 12th Armored Division in Western Germany. A member of the division's Headquarters Company, 56th Armored Infantry Battalion, he was cited as follows:

"On at least two occasions S/Sgt. Keeler was heavily shelled by artillery and near Worms, Germany, he was bombed and strafed while working in a disabled vehicle. He was slightly wounded during this period, but remained at his post. Through his excellent standards of maintenance and ingenuity, S/Sgt. Keeler enabled all of the heavy weapons and communications vehicles of Headquarters and Headquarters Company, to be in position to support the assaulting troops during every attack of the Task Force Norton.
