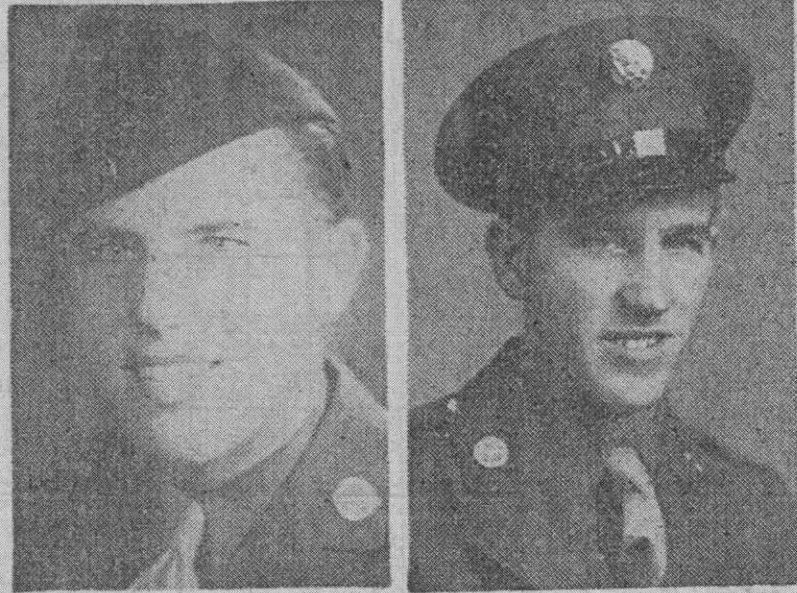


Ezar, Andrew
