Given Award



Mrs. James Loughman, 122 Mechanic Street, received word that her husband, Pfc. James Loughman, was awarded the Bronze Star Medal in connection with military operations against the enemy of the United States from July, 1944, to May, 1945.

According to a citation accompanying the award, "During this entire period Pfc. James Loughman maintained vitally important messenger communications with front line units. Pfc. Loughman's courage and devotion to duty merit the highest praise and reflect the finest tradition of the military service of the United States." JUL 26 1945

Loughman served with the 329th Infantry Regiment, 83rd Division. He is a former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company.
