Mr. and Mrs. William G. Stark, 1604 Millard Street, received word of the marriage in Paris on April 11 of their daughter, First Lieut. Hildegard M. Stark, and First Lieut. William I. Wright, son of Mrs. D. R. Wright and the late Mr. Wright of Elkhart, Indiana.

The attendants were Miss Marjorie Buehler, serving with the American Red Cross in France, and Corporal John Eason, of Elkhart, Indiana, a college classmate of the bridegroom.

After spending a short honeymoon in Paris, the bride returned to duty with the 24th Evacuation Hospital in Germany and the bridegroom to service with the Seventh Army.

The bride was graduated from Liberty High School and from the Presbyterian Hospital, Philadelphia, Training School for Nurses in March, 1941. She was assistant head nurse in the Urological Department before receiving her commission as Second Lieutenant in the Army Nurse Corps in November, 1942, and went overseas in June, 1944.

The bridegroom was graduated from Elkhart School and from Indiana University, class of 1942. While attending the University he became a member of the Delta Upsilon national fraternity. He was a member of the Indiana Accounting Club and of the Scabbard and Blade, a national honorary military fraternity. Upon graduation he received the Bachelor of Science degree in business as well as a commission in the Reserved Officers Corps as Second Lieutenant in the Infantry.
