Former Bethlehem Steel Company Looper Now With Engineers in Africa.

Word has just been received by his wife here of the promotion of Captain John Morrison, former Bethlehem Steel Company looper, to the rank of major with the United States Army engineers in Africa.

Major Morrison is the son of Mrs. Maurice Morrison, Chillicothe, O., and was graduated from Ohio State University where he was a member of Tau Beta Pi fraternity. He was a member of the Society of Civil Engineering. He left the Steel Company in September, 1937, to take a commission in the Army engineering corps. In August, 1937, he had married Miss Klein. Mr. and Mrs. Morrison spent two years in Kansas and the next in Massachusetts where Mr. Morrison earned his master's degree at Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

After inauguration of Selective Service, Major Morrison's transfers were many and frequent and Mrs. Morrison came to Bethlehem to make her home. Major Morrison arrived in England in June and last week Mrs. Morrison received a letter from him in Africa.
