Preparation for her Navy career as a storekeeper was begun recently by Woman Reservist Frances Evelyn Heisler, 22, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Paul Jacob Heisler, 1348 Easton Avenue, this city, with her enrollment in the Naval Training School for women storekeepers on the Indiana University campus at Bloomington, Ind.

Past civilian experience and "boot" training aptitude tests are the basis for selection to the school.

At Indiana she will receive expert instruction in storing, recording, reporting, requisitioning and invoicing stocks. Classroom curriculum is supplemented with physical training and recreation periods.

Advancement to the petty officer rate of storekeeper third class awaits the feminine Bluejacket upon graduation from the Indiana campus.
