Killed In Action

Private Stanley A. Nocek, 21-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Stanley Nocek, Steel City has been reported killed in action during the initial paratroop landings on Corregidor, February 16, in a War Department telegram received yesterday. Pvt. Nocek volunteered for duty in the U. S. Army in May, 1939, and was sent to Fort Monroe, Va.; Fort Story, Va.; Fort Miles, Del.; Fort Jackson, S. C., and Fort Bragg, N. C., before he transferred to the paratroopers. He was sent to Fort Benning, Ga., and overseas in November of last year. He was stationed in New Guinea and in the Philippines before going to Corregidor. Two brothers are also in the armed forces. They are S 1/C Louis J. Nocek and Pvt. Joseph F. Nocek, with the First Army in Europe.
