## 19-Year-Old G-I Killed In Germany

Pfc. Warren W. Wright, 19-year-old infantry soldier, was killed in action in Germany, his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Ebon R. Wright, 1431 Center Street, were informed by the War Department yesterday.

Pfc. Wright was inducted February 17, 1944 and had been serving on active overseas duty since November. He was a graduate of Liberty High School and a former employe of the Laros Textile Company. Two brothers are also serving in the armed forces, Sgt. Ebon R. Wright, Jr., stationed in France with a photo-technician unit; and Pfc. John Arthur Wright, stationed at Peterson Field, Colorado Springs. In addition to his parents and two brothers, he is survived by a sister Jane and another brother, Robert, at home.
