Mrs. Merritt Smith of 1032 Mauch Chunk Road, received the Purple Heart award made to her son, Pfc. Llewellyn Cope, wounded in France on June 13, on Thursday. Mrs. Smith had been previously notified of her son's injury and since that time has received a letter from him which states he was wounded in the shoulder.

Pfc. Cope received his training at Army camps in Arkansas, Maryland and the New England States before going overseas to England and then to France. He has one step-brother, Sgt. Merritt Smith, Jr., in the service, stationed in New Guinea.
