Commissions For Three Men In Air Corps

Three young men from this area were commissioned second Lieutenants in the United States Army Air Forces recently. They are Luther W. Eisenhart, 26, son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert H. Lieutenants Eisenhart and Payne were graduated from the Army Air Corps training base at Ellington Field, Texas, as navigators. They were members of Class 44-9. Lieutenant Manone graduated as a bombardier navigator at Victorville Army Air Field, Victorville, Calif.
