Gold Star Service For Pfc. Alberta yes

A Gold Star service will be held Sunday at 4 p. m. in Emmanuel Evangelical Congregational Church or Pfc. Albert T. Hayes, first member of that congregation to pay the supreme sacrifice in World War II. He was killed in action Christmas Day, 1944, according to a final report by the War Department regarding his case. He was reported missing on January 15, and presumed to be dead as of March 12. Pfc. Hayes was a member of Boy Scout Troop No. 9 of the church, oldest troop in the city with an unbroken charter. He was a member of a Sunday School class taught by George Metzgar and also a member of the church.
