### **Lt. William Stump Ends AAF Service**

First Lt. William L. Stump, 24, son of Mr. and Mrs. William E. Stump, 608 Fourth Avenue, this city, was honorably discharged from the Army Air Forces today.

Lt. Stump entered the service in January, 1943, at Miami Beach. He served seven months overseas as a B-24 pilot with the 15th Air Force in the European Theater of Operations. He holds the European Theater Ribbon with six battle stars, and the Air Medal with one oak leaf cluster. He completed 24 missions with a total of 200 combat hours.

Lt. Stump is a graduate of Bethlehem High School and attended Lehigh University for four years.

His last Army Air Force station was the Fourth Ferrying Group, Ferrying Division, Air Transport Command, Memphis, Tenn.
