**John J. G. Enright
Now A Corporal;
Serves in Philippines**

HEADQUARTERS, 13TH AAF, Philippines—John J. G. Enright, son of John D. Enright, who reside at 1224 Wood Stret, Bethlehem, has recently been promoted to the grade of corporal. He has seen foreign duty for 12 months as a supply clerk with an aircraft maintenance unit of the 13th Air Force, veteran Jungle Air Force, which has battled the Japs from Guadalcanal to China.

Corporal Enright attended Bethlehem High School and formerly was employed by the Billing Division of Bethlehem Steel Company.

He entered the Army in March 1943 and trained at St. Petersburg, Fla., attended AAF clerical school at Fort Logan, Colo., and became a member of the permanent personnel at the Army Air Base, Santa Anna, Calif. He received overseas training at Kearns, Utah, prior to going overseas in August, 1944.

The soldier wears the Asiatic-Pacific Theatre Ribbon with three Battle stars and the Philippine Liberation Ribbon with one Bronze star for service in combat zones.
