From Camp Davis, N. C., comes word of the granting of a commission as second lieutenant in the United States Army to Lloyd Arthur Fatzinger (whose picture appears with this article), son of Mr. and Mrs.

James A. Fatzinger, 1056 Jeter Avenue, this city. Lieutenant Fatzinger graduated from the Anti-Aircraft Artillery School, officer candidate division, at Camp Davis, along with a number of other young men at recently held exercises.

He entered the officer candidate school on October 10, 1942, after having held the rank of corporal. Before going into the Army he had been employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company. He attended Moravian College for Men and was active there in the choir and glee club, was head cheer leader and a reporter on the college newspaper, The Comenian.
