## Memorial Rite Held for Soldier Killed in Action

In connection with the morning worship on Sunday in St. Peter's Lutheran Church, Dr. Corson C. Snyder conducted memorial rites for the late Pfc. Owen R. Reiman, son of Lloyd Reiman, 605 Broadway, killed in action on Iwo Jima on March 17. He entered the service on September 7, 1942.

Following the sermon on "Peace Be Unto You," Dr. Snyder read the "Memorial Service for Those Who Die in the Service of Our Country," as prepared by the Common Service Book Committee.

Mrs. W. J. Doorley sang Handel's "I Know That My Redeemer Liveth" and the choir rendered the anthem "Lives Again Our Glorious King," an Easter hymn.
