Bethlehemite Plays In Navy Band Concert

Angelo Borghi, formerly of this city, was a member of the 110-piece band which combined with a 100-voice chorus in presenting the Second Annual Fall Concert of the United States Navy School of Music. A capacity audience filled famous Constitution Hall, Washington, D. C. to hear the instrumental and choral groups under the baton of Lieut. (j.g.) James W. Thurmond, USN, Officer-in-Charge of the school. Music lovers and critics acclaimed the efforts of the 210 blue-jackets.

Mr. Borghi is a student in the Navy Service School which is designed to train sailor musicians. Af-

ter completing the prescribed school course which is approximately one year in length, the sailor-musicians are graduated in versatile, balanced units of twenty men under the leadership of a school-trained bandmaster. These bands are assigned to ships and shore stations and remain intact for the remaining five years of their enlistment.
