T/5 Saul C. Roth, 437 Third Avenue, is one of the several hundred men busily engaged in preparing soldiers for immediate return to the United States east coast from the port of Karachi, India.

He is a member of the port of embarkation staff in downtown Karachi, where the administrative detail of loading a ship on schedule is carried out. This is the last overseas stop for men and women of the armed forces on the way to New York, Hampton Roads or Boston.

T/5 Roth sees that incoming troops are given a hot meal and assigned billets. Then comes processing, which requires only two hours, records are checked, clothing shortages made up and each man is given an influenza shot and partial or full pay.
