Quakertown Sailor Is Killed In Action

Charles Darwin Benner, radio man second class, of Quakertown, has been reported by the Navy Department, "killed in action in the faithful performance of his duty to his country, and has been buried in Allied territory."

Benner, who would have been 21 in November, was the son of Mrs. Gertrude Benner of Richlandtown. His father, William E. Benner, died a number of years ago.

Seaman Benner was a graduate of Quakertown High School, class of 1941, and has two brothers in the service, William in the Army, and Donald in the Navy. Another brother, Robert, is awaiting induction. Two other brothers and three sisters survive. MAY 20 1944
