Loses Life In France On July 15

Sergeant Kenneth Fielder Pardee, husband of the former Miss Doris Roemer, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Henry Roemer, of 15 West Laurel Street, city, was killed in action, July 15, in France, according to word received by the Roemer's.

Sergeant Pardee was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Howard J. Pardee of Upper Montclair, N. J. He mar-

ried Miss Roemer June 13, 1942. He is a graduate of Manlius School, N. Y., and was a chemical engineer student at Lehigh with the class of 1941, prior to enlisting with the first volunteer draft in February of 1941.

He was attached to the 13th Infantry and went overseas November of 1943. Until a month ago, Sergeant Pardee was stationed in Northern Ireland.

He was born October 15, 1919, in Massachusetts, and is survived by a brother, Robert, in Philadelphia, in addition to his wife and parents.
