## TO HONOR MORAVIAN ALUMNI IN SERVICE

Marine Chaplain, to Conduct  
Opening Program of Day.

Commander A. DeG. Vogler of the U. S. Navy, who is stationed at present as chaplain at the Marine Corps Base, Parris Island, S. C., will conduct a special chapel service in honor of Moravian alumni who are in the armed service of the nation at 11:30 a. m. Saturday as the opening event of the Moravian Alumni Day program.

Commander Vogler who is the father of William H. Vogler, a member of this year's graduating class at Moravian, is also a graduate of Moravian with the class of 1909. The Commander and Mrs. Vogler arrived in Bethlehem yesterday for the Moravian Commencement season.

The service will be held in Borhek Memorial Chapel on the campus and will be a service of recognition and prayer in behalf of approximately 60 alumni and former students who are serving with the various branches of the armed forces. Charles C. Albrecht, '30, president of the Alumni Association, will introduce Commander Vogler.
