

The Banana Factory is featuring its second Young Artists Exhibition, a display highlighting the artistic talents of local students, in the Banko Family Community Room Gallery from April 21 to May 27. The opening reception for this exhibition coincides with our First Friday on May 5 from 6 - 9 p.m.

The exhibition is curated by Susan Berkenstock, art teacher at Fountain Hill Elementary School in Bethlehem, Pa., and Lois Hofschild, Banana Factory artist and arts-in-education program teacher at the Banana Factory.

Any 2-dimensional media is eligible. Please see below for format requirements.

This exhibition is an excellent opportunity for students to exhibit their works in a professional setting. The five-week show is open to the public Monday through Saturday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Eligibility:

Jurying takes place in each of four grade categories: $K - 2^{nd}$ $3^{rd} - 5^{th}$ $6^{th} - 8^{th}$ $9^{th} - 12^{th}$

2-dimensional works must be done in one of the following formats:

8" x 10" 9" x 12" 12" x 18" 18" x 24"

Each artist may submit up to two works. Any artist of school age residing in Northampton, Lehigh, Bucks or Berks counties is eligible to enter. All works must be original and completed within the last year.
