Pfc. Paul Lippert, son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Lippert Sr., 1059 Third Avenue, Hellertown, was seriously wounded in action in France on July 26, according to a message received yesterday by his parents. No details were contained in the War Department's telegram.

Prior to his induction into the service Private Lippert was engaged as a machinist with the Bethlehem Steel Company. He was inducted November 7, 1943, and after training in Alabama, Tennessee and Arizona was sent overseas, first to Ireland, England and then France.
