**Get Purple Heart
Awarded Son
Killed In Action**

Mr. and Mrs. Martin Snyder, 1667 East Twelfth Street, received the Purple Heart awarded to their son, Pvt. Paul M. Snyder, killed in action in Normandy, France, July 23, 1944.

The 19-year-old soldier had been serving with the infantry overseas for two and a half months. He entered the service November 20, 1943, and received his training at Fort McClellan, Ala., and Fort George G. Meade, Md. His parents, a brother and two sisters survive.
